† **14 DAY SANCTUARY LAMP:** is burning for the weeks of (10/28 to 11/10) for the **INTENTIONS** of **Ann Williamitis**. If you would like to donate to light the 14 day sanctuary candle for your intention, please let Father know. The **donation** for each candle is **\$25** (candles generally last 14 days, but sometimes they burn faster than expected).

Indulgences granted for the Faithful Departed during the month of November:

1) Beginning on November 1st, at noon and continuing to Midnight, November 2nd, the Catholic Faithful, as often as they visit a Church to pray for the dead, reciting 6 times during the visit the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be for the intentions of Holy Mother the Church, may gain: A Plenary Indulgence applicable only to the souls in purgatory. This indulgence may also be gained from noon of the following Saturday until Sunday at Midnight, but only those who did not gain the indulgence on All Souls' Day (The confession can be made on the day in question or anytime during the week before or after. Holy Communion can be made on the day in question or within the following week or one day before the day in question) Raccolta #590.

2) The Faithful who during the period of 8 days from the commemoration of All Souls inclusive, visit a cemetery in a spirit of piety and devotion and pray, even mentally for the dead may gain: A Plenary Indulgence on the usual conditions on each day of the octave, applicable only to the faithful departed (The usual conditions are listed below. Note that for this particular indulgence, it is necessary to also visit a Church and pray at least one Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be, for the intentions of the Church, one visit per each time one wishes to gain the plenary indulgence (Reply from the Sacred Congregation of Indulgences (February 29, 1864).

3) Those souls who make such a visit, and pray for the Holy Souls, on any day of the year, may gain: An Indulgence of 7 years, applicable only to the faithful departed. Raccolta #592

4) The faithful who recite prayers or perform other devout exercises in supplication for the faithful departed during the month of November, may gain: An Indulgence of 3 years, once each day; A Plenary Indulgence on the usual conditions, at the end of their 7 or 9 days of prayer. Raccolta #589

5) Those who during the aforesaid month, take part in public services held in a church or public oratory in intercession for the faithful departed may gain: An Indulgence of 7 years, on each day of the month; A Plenary Indulgence, if they attend these exercises on at least 15 days, and in addition go to confession, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the intentions of Holy Mother the Church. 6) The Faithful who devoutly offer prayers at any season of the year in intercession for the souls of the Faithful departed, with the intention of so continuing for 7 or 9 successive days may obtain: An Indulgence of 3 years once each day, A Plenary Indulgence on the usual conditions at the end of their 7 or 9 days of prayer. Raccolta #588

7) All Masses that are celebrated at any altar by any Priest within the period of 8 days from the commemoration of All Souls Inclusive, enjoy the same privilege as if they were offered in a privileged altar, but only in favor of the soul for whom they are applied. Raccolta #591

Conditions for Gaining an Indulgence: 1) Be in a state of grace. 2) Have the intention of gaining the indulgence. 3) Perform the work required (If vocal prayer is required, one must at least move one's lips).

If it is a Plenary Indulgence one must also: 1) Have true sorrow for all one's sins. 2) Go to confession and receive Holy Communion. 3) Pray one Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be for the intentions of Holy Mother Church (unless more is specifically required). 4) Make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament.

The Intentions of the Pope (Or of the Church during Vacancy) are: 1) The Exaltation of the Church. 2) Extirpation of Heresy. 3) Propagation of the Faith. 4) Conversion of Sinners. 5) Peace and Concord among Christian rulers.

It is sufficient to have the general intention as above, even if one doesn't know what the specific intentions are.

Confessions: 45 minutes before Sunday Masses. 30 minutes before weekday Masses. Father will stop hearing confessions 10 minutes before Mass. Confessions could be heard after Mass as well.

Baptism: Please call Father to make arrangements. At least one parent and the sponsors must be practicing traditional Catholics. It is a serious obligation for Catholics to have their newborns baptized within two weeks.

Matrimony: For practicing registered parishioners only. Please contact Father at least six months before the wedding date for marriage instructions.

Mass Intentions may be submitted for a stipend of \$25.00. Mass intention envelopes are available in the vestibule.

Blessing of Religious Articles: Please bring item(s) up to Communion Rail after Holy Mass.
