† On Wednesday, November 1st, **All Saints' Day is a Holy Day of Obligation.** Mass will be at 6 pm.

† **November 2** is **All Souls Day.** There will be three Masses that day: 7 am, 7:45 am, and 6 pm.

† **No Adult Catechism** this Wednesday (11/1). Will be moved to Nov. 8th.

† **First Friday & First Saturday** this coming week. To make reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

† There will be **Catechism Classes with the Sisters** for the children and teenagers on **November 5th** and **12th.**

† **Christ the King & All Saints party** will be held today after the 10 am Mass. Location will be at the Hall of Lebanon Christian School. 15 E. Warren St., Lebanon, OH 45036. There will be games and activities for the children as well. **Please bring a main dish to share.**

† **Indulgences for the Poor Souls in the Month of November:** **1.** The faithful who recite the prayers or perform other devout exercises in supplication for the faithful departed during the month of November, may gain: An indulgence of 3 years once on each day of the month; A plenary indulgence on the usual conditions, if they perform these devotions daily for the entire month (Raccolta, 589). **2.** Those who, during the aforesaid month, take part in public services held in a church or public oratory in intercession for the faithful departed may gain: An indulgence of 7 years on each day of the month; A plenary indulgence, if they attend these exercises on at least fifteen days and, in addition, go to confession, receive Holy Communion and pray for the intentions of the Church (Raccolta, 589). **3.** From noon All Saints Day to midnight of All Souls Day: The faithful, as often as they visit a church or public oratory in order to pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the souls in purgatory, on condition of confession and Communion, and the recitation of six times during each visit of Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be for the intentions of the Church. (This indulgence may also be gained on the following Sunday, but only by those who did not gain it on Nov. 1st or 2nd) (Raccolta, 590). **4.** The faithful who during the period of eight days from All Souls Day (counting All Souls Day itself) visit a cemetery in a spirit of piety and devotion, and pray, even mentally, for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence on the usual conditions, on each day of the Octave, applicable only to the dead (Raccolta, 592).

Whenever a plenary indulgence says it is granted under the "usual conditions" that means the following must be done in order to gain the indulgence: **1.** "The usual conditions for gaining a plenary indulgence are: **confession; Communion; visit to a church or public oratory** (or semi-public oratory for those who have the right to use it, if no church or public oratory is attached, provided nothing special is prescribed); **prayer for the Pope's intentions.** It is to be noted that the usual conditions are not always prescribed, e.g., none of them are really prescribed for gaining the indulgence of the Way of the Cross." (Winfred Herbst, S.D.S. *The Church Suffering.* Emphasis added.) **2.** The confession can be made on the day in question or anytime during the week before or after. Holy Communion can be made on the day in question or within the following week or *one* day before the day in question. **3.** The faithful who are in the habit of confessing at least twice a month unless legitimately impeded, or who receive Holy Communion daily in the state of grace and with a good and holy intention, though they may abstain from receiving once or twice a week, can gain all indulgences without actual confession for which otherwise confession would be a necessary condition (Canon 931).

† **Petition to St. Therese** to help find a building for the school, convent, and rectory, and as always, gratitude and thanksgiving for what we have received. So, I would like to begin a petition to St. Therese for these intentions. The Novena Prayer to St. Therese after each Low Mass will be for these intentions.

Confessions: 45 minutes before Sunday Masses. 30 minutes before weekday Masses. Father will stop hearing confessions 10 minutes before Mass. Confessions could be heard after Mass as well.

Baptism: Please call Father to make arrangements. At least one parent and the sponsors must be practicing traditional Catholics. It is a serious obligation for Catholics to have their newborns baptized within two weeks.

Matrimony: For practicing registered parishioners only. Please contact Father at least six months before the wedding date for marriage instructions.

Mass Intentions may be submitted for a stipend of \$25.00. Mass intention envelopes are available in the vestibule.
